Regulations

Team registration and payment must be received by May 31st 2018

All TAPT Special needs road-e-o contestants, to be eligible for competition drivers must meet the following requirements.

Drivers:

- * Must be at least 18 yrs. of age.
- * Must have a valid CDL driver's license class A or B with a passenger and school bus endorsement.
- * Must hold a current valid state certification card (Enrollment certificate not valid)
- * Must have a current valid physical medical card.
- * Must have no chargeable school bus accidents.

Driver and Attendant:

- Must be employed by a school district, charter or contract company.
- Eligible contestant is open to all Transportation department personnel.

No Local district substitutions will be allowed for state competition. Only the registered Regional winning team or designated alternate team.

Drivers and Attendants may not switch positions before, during or at any time during the competition. Each team must compete as they competed in the Regional competition.

Registration must be submitted for alternates as well as contestants

- *During competition, contestants will be required to stay in the driver's preparation area until called for competition. Drivers and assistants are not allowed on the course during any of the events except while competing.
- *No scores will be provided prior to the Award Ceremony. Summary sheets will be provided to each contestant after the award presentation.
