

TAPT Special Needs Team Safety Competition (Rodeo)

Team registration and payment must be received by May 31, 2019

Eligibility: TAPT Special Needs Rodeo contestants must meet the following requirements:

Driver:

- Must be at least 18 yrs. of age.
- Must have a valid Commercial Driver's License - Class A or B with both Passenger and School Bus Endorsements
- Must hold a current valid School Bus Driver Certification Card. (Enrollment certificate not valid)
- Must have a current valid physical medical card.
- Must have no chargeable accidents since August 1, 2018.

Driver and Attendant:

- Must be employed by a school district, charter or contract company.
- Must be actively involved in transportation operations as a driver or other staff member.

Please note the following rules:

No District substitutions will be allowed for state competition. Only the original two members of the Regional winning team or designated alternate team will be allowed to compete.

Drivers and Attendants may not switch positions before, during or at any time during the competition. Each team must compete as they competed in the Regional competition.

Registration must be submitted for alternates as well as contestants if they are to fill in at the state level.

During competition, contestants will be required to remain in the Driver Preparation Area until called for competition.

Drivers and assistants are not allowed on the course during any of the events except while competing. No cell phone use will be allowed while competing.

No scores will be provided prior to the Award Ceremony. Summary sheets will be provided to each contestant after the award presentation.
