SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Texas Association for Pupil Transportation Vocational/Technical (Trade School) Scholarship is sponsored and administered by the Texas Association for Pupil Transportation. This scholarship is a reflection of the organization's continued commitment to the youth of the state and support for its membership.

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance for a qualified applicant who will be entering a vocational/technical or trade school of higher learning. The applicant should have a sound academic record, be of good character and demonstrate financial need.

Amount of Scholarship There will be one \$1,000.00 scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements

To receive the scholarship, an applicant must:

1. Be a family member or any employee of the transportation department of any Texas school district (son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter).
2. Have a diploma, certificate of completion, or GED from a Texas accredited school.
3. Be eligible and have applied for admission in a recognized educational, vocational/technical or trade school.

Selection Committee

The selection committee will be composed of the TAPT President or his designee and the five (5) Area Directors of the Executive Committee.
