

## Texas Association for Pupil Transportation Student Scholarships Checklist

- TAPT & Chalk's Truck Parts Vocational/Technical Scholarship Application** (family member of any employee of the transportation department of any Texas school district)

Note: *Family member must be son, daughter, grandson or granddaughter.*

*Eligibility requirements and documentation requirements for each scholarship can be found on the individual information sheets. Please apply only for the scholarships for which you are eligible.*

Complete and attach the application for the Texas Association for Pupil Transportation Scholarships. Fill out only one application even if you are eligible for and are applying for more than one scholarship. Just check the appropriate box(es).

Attach your transcript showing your academic work, your class rank, the number of students in your class, your grade point average, and your college admission scores.

Attach a letter of reference from your high school counselor addressing your character and the attainability of your educational goals.

Attach a letter from your high school principal addressing your character and your attendance. (This can be your grade level principal.)

Attach letters of reference from one of the following: your current English, Math, Science, or Social Studies teacher. The letter should address your work ethic and your reliability.

Attach a letter of recommendation from your parent or guardian. The letter should address your talents, abilities, goals, etc.

Attach the essay(s) as required in the application. Read the application carefully.

Attach a copy of your GED and transcript of high school course work completed if applicable (for the TAPT & Chalk's Truck Parts Vocational/Technical Scholarship only).

**NOTE: Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline will not be considered.**

Application and all required information must be completed and mailed to the TAPT Office, 147 Lawhon Lane, Waco, TX 76708. Materials must be received no later than April 15<sup>th</sup> of the current year. The recipient will be notified by May 20, of the current year.
