

Ryan Woods Foundation Scholarship

The Ryan Woods Foundation Scholarship is sponsored by Tony Woods, a member in superb standings with TAPT and Chief Executive Officer of Woods Leadership Group, LP. The Woods Leadership group subsidiaries include AMA, Inc., Bus Air Manufacturing, LLC, and TCB Surveillance. The scholarship is to be administered by the Texas Association for Pupil Transportation in honor of Ryan Woods, Tony's son, who developed Type 1 Diabetes at seven (7) years of age and who continues to fight this disease. It is the hope of all those connected with the Woods Leadership Group that this scholarship will not only help a deserving high school student who also has Type 1 Diabetes, but will serve to bring greater awareness to the dangers of Juvenile Diabetes.

The scholarship is provided for a graduating student of any High School in the state of Texas, who has Type 1 Diabetes, to assist with medical expenditures accrued due to this dreaded disease during the school year in which the scholarship is awarded.

This scholarship will provide a grant of \$1000.00 each year for a selected participant, for a period of two years, in either an either an approved two year or four year program resulting in a vocational or academic degree.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Graduating Senior of ANY Texas High School who has Type 1 Diabetes.
2. Eligible for admission in selected educational institution.
3. Maintain acceptable attendance and scholastic performance each semester for the term of the scholarship.
4. Recipient must be present at the TAPT Annual Conference in order to receive the scholarship.

SELECTION:

The scholarship recipient will be chosen from written applications and possible personal interviews by the scholarship selection committee. The selection committee shall consist of the TAPT President (or his/her designee), the five Area Directors on the Executive Committee, and Tony Woods.
