



2022 TAPT Special Needs Bus Road-e-o

The following students will be aboard your school bus during the **emergency event**. You will need to familiarize yourself with these students and their specific challenges.

Tony: Is 17 years old with bi-polar syndrome and can be very aggressive with other students. Tony's condition is usually triggered by loud screaming and yelling and is known to lose his patients, note Tony is the last one to be dropped off on a daily basis.

Abby: is 15 years old who is legally blind. Abby can hear and understand verbal communication with others but can easily get scared when loud sounds are around her. Abby uses a cane to get around; without it, she gets paranoid.

Zach: is 18 years old and was diagnosed with Misophonia or Hyperacusis disorder. Zach can get very angry, stressed, and create anxiety as he is very sensitive to any kind of sound. Zach will usually cover his ears and tuck his head between his legs and will refuse to move until he feels all sounds have gone.

Sandy: is 17 years old with an Asthma disorder. When Sandy is scared or when she panics, it will trigger an asthma attack and requires close attention. Her breathing will become shallow and requires an inhaler. Sandy carries an inhaler with her at all times. Without it, she might faint or panic that might require CPR.
