You will need to familiarize yourself with these students and their specific challenges.

Isabella is a spirited 13-year-old navigating the challenges of **Hutchinson-Gilford Progeria Syndrome**. In addition to managing **hypoglycemia**, which requires her to wear a continuous monitor, Isabella’s physical fragility means she performs best when given her own seating space for safety. Beyond her medical needs, she is a huge fan of **K-Pop** and the series ***Demon Slayer***, and she finds great joy in singing.

Fez is a 14-year-old student diagnosed with **Kabuki Syndrome**. He utilizes fidget tools effectively for sensory regulation; however, he struggles with appropriate attention-seeking behaviors. When he feels overlooked—specifically after an initial verbal attempt to engage—he may escalate to throwing available objects, such as his shoes. Fez shows a strong preference for proximity and thrives when a 1:1 monitor is seated nearby. He may become vocally distressed or yell if staff move away, signaling a need for consistent physical presence or a structured transition.
